REGISTRATION DATES?

Registration for the Youth Tackle Football Leagues will begin **Wednesday, July 1st**. Deadline to register is **Friday, August 21st**.

LEAGUES OFFERED & ELIGIBILITY?

The child's age on September 1st of this year determines the division of play.

Tackle Football: Small Fry Division - For boys and girls ages 9 & 10

Mite Division – For boys and girls ages 11 & 12

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST TO REGISTER MY CHILD?

The cost for registering is based on the current residence of the participant.

*A discount does apply to families with multiple children involved. *A \$5.00 credit may be issued if another child is participating in Conway Parks & Recreation Spring Sports.*

Check, Visa/MasterCard and Discover are acceptable forms of payment (**No Cash**). Note: There is a **\$30.00** service charge on all returned checks. *(If check is returned, child may not participate until the matter is resolved.)*

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION FEE?

Each player will receive: Jersey, Socks and Mouthpiece *(which they get to keep)*
Helmet, Shoulder Pads and Pants with pads *(which are on loan, they must be returned at the end of the season.)* There is a \$20.00 fee if certified sticker on helmet is removed or missing when returned.

WHAT EQUIPMENT DOES MY CHILD NEED FOR PRACTICES/GAMES?

Shorts, T-Shirt & Proper Athletic Shoes *(Proper athletic shoes are either sneakers or cleats. Cleats are not a requirement for participation in any youth league. If your child would like cleats the soles must be made of rubber or plastic.)*

HOW IS MY CHILD PLACED ON A TEAM?

Skills Assessments for Small Fry (9-10) will be held on Tuesday August 25th @ 6:00 pm and the Mite (11-12) will be held on Wednesday August 26th @ 6:00 pm. Both Skills Assessments will meet on football field #1 (on Mill Pond by Cannon's Small engine). **Players returning to the same age group as the previous year, do not have to attend placements.** *After the skills assessments are held, the head coaches will meet for the league's draft. Your child will then be placed on a team and your coach will contact you with practice information. No requests are guaranteed.*

WHEN WILL THE PARENT INFORMATION MEETING BE HELD?

The Parents information meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 16th at 6:00 pm in the Conway Senior Center. Topics to be discussed are league rules, playing time, how to handle problems and all- star information.

WHEN WILL PRACTICES BEGIN?

Practices will begin the week of September 1st. Teams may practice 3 days per week before the season begins. Teams will play/practice a maximum of 3 days per week during the season. Practice time is limited to 1 ½ hours on weeknights, 2 hours on weekends.

WHEN WILL GAMES BEGIN?

Games will begin the week of September 28th

WHAT DAYS OF THE WEEK WILL MY CHILD BE PLAYING?

Small Fry and Mite football will play on Monday through Thursday and Saturdays. *Game times are 5:30, 6:30 and 7:30 (Mite) during the week and Saturday mornings at 9:00, 10:00 and 11:00 am. (Game days and times subject to change depending on field availability)*
