*The child's age on **April 30, 2026** determines the division of play for the T-Ball, Coach Pitch, and Baseball leagues.*

Coach Pitch for ages 8 and under

Minors League for ages 10 and under

Youth League for ages 12 and under

Junior League for ages 14 and under

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST TO REGISTER MY CHILD?

The cost for registering is based on the current residence of the participant.

Non-Resident	-	\$75.00

*A \$10.00 late fee will be applied for registrations
Received after February 28*

*A discount does apply to families with multiple children involved. *A \$5.00 credit may be issued if another child is participating in Conway Parks & Recreation Spring Sports.*

Cash, Check, Visa/MasterCard and Discover are acceptable forms of payment.

Note: Those who have outstanding balances or fail to return equipment will not be eligible to register until account is in good standings. There is a \$30.00 service charge on all returned checks/charge backs. *(If check is returned, child may not participate until the matter is resolved.)*

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION FEE?

Each player will receive a game jersey and hat. Contact Conway Parks & Recreation for additional information. (843) 488-1950. **Jersey size requested is not guaranteed.**

WHAT EQUIPMENT DOES MY CHILD NEED FOR PRACTICES/GAMES?

Your child will need proper athletic shoes, pants, and glove. If your child plays catcher, they will need an athletic supporter (*recommended for all participants*). Proper athletic shoes are either sneakers or cleats. Cleats are not a requirement for participation in any youth league. If your child would like to wear cleats, the soles must be made of rubber or plastic. In Boys league: Metal spikes are allowed.

WHEN WILL THE PARENT INFORMATION MEETING BE HELD?

A Parents' information meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 18th at 6:00pm in the Conway Senior Center. Topics discussed are rules, playing time, how to handle problems and other relative information.

HOW WILL MY CHILD BE PLACED ON A TEAM?

Skills Assessments will be held for all leagues ages 9 and up. Skills Assessments will be held at the Conway Recreation Complex for the following leagues. All players must attend.

Tee Ball (6 and Under) and Coach Pitch (8 and Under) will be contacted by their coach by March 15th

Minors (10U) Skills Assessment: Tuesday, March 3rd @ 6:00 pm on field B.

Youth (12U) Skills Assessment: Thursday, March 5th @ 6:00 pm on field E.

Boys (14U) Skills Assessment TBD (after BSquad school ball) @ 6:00 pm on field A.

After the skills assessments are held, the head coaches will meet for the league's draft. Your child will then be placed on a team and your coach will contact you with practice information. If you have not heard from your coach by these dates, please call us at (843) 488-1950.

WHEN WILL PRACTICES BEGIN?

Practices for Minors and Youth will begin the week of March 9th. Boys will start in late April. Tee Ball and Coach Pitch will begin week of March 16th. Teams are limited to two practices per week.

Maximum practice time is Monday – Friday (90 minutes) & Saturday (2 hours).

WHEN WILL GAMES BEGIN

Games for Minors and Youth will begin the week of April 13th (Jamboree Sat. April 11th). Games for Boys will begin around April 27th (at the conclusion of High School play). Tee Ball and Coach pitch will begin the week of April 13th. Games will be played Monday through Saturday and the seasons will end by the first of June.
